UK National Aviation Security Update

The revised programme came in to force on the 29 April 2010. New European Commission rules will set common basic standards in the field of aviation security that all Member States will be required to meet as a minimum. These common standards are supplemented by the UK Single Consolidated Direction (Aviation) 2010 (SCD) which contains additional measures they assess to be necessary in the light of the terrorist threat to the UK.
