The Airside Driving course is classroom based and is in accordance with CAA CAP642 guidance. The course ensures personnel that drive airside are aware of the rules and key regulations that govern their movements at the airport, it includes airfield safety practices and radio procedures.

AUDITING IN A MAINTENANCE ENVIRONMENT
